Opened in 2003, the NHH employs close to 600 people and is an active member of the Central East Local Health Integration Network. The hospital's broad range of services includes:

- A full suite of diagnostic imaging services, including state-of-the-art CT and MRI, all on digital platform
- A variety of ambulatory care clinics
- Sponsorship of a mental health program

The NHH Emergency Department

The NHH ED delivers quality medical care to more 32,500 patients every year.

- The main ED comprises 22 beds and a Blue Zone Clinic (rapid assessment of Canadian Triage and Acuity Scale 3 & 4 patients)
- The ED is staffed by a dedicated team of professionals, including a Nurse Practitioner and a dedicated Chief of Emergency Medicine who works closely with administration and hospital staff
- A mix of full and part-time physicians work in the ED with a schedule that typically affords ample time off
- Full and part-time work is available (with an equitable distribution of night shift assignments)
- NHH ED physicians utilize a web-based scheduling system

Nestled along the shores of Lake Ontario and among the rolling hills of Northumberland County, Cobourg is rich in heritage, history and cosmopolitan charm.
