*Treatment facilities for the Algoma District Cancer Program are located within the brand new Sault Area Hospital (SAH). This state-of-the-art community hospital operates 291 beds, including acute, chronic care, rehabilitation and mental health beds, and 10 Level 3 neonatal intensive care bassinets. The SAH provides emergency, primary, secondary and tertiary hospital services.*

- The Algoma District Cancer Program provides care to patients of all ages and in all stages of living with cancer.
- The cancer program offers a full range of services in medical oncology, palliative care and support services including nutrition, oncologic pharmacy, social work and clinical trials (both cooperative group and industry-sponsored trials).
- It is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team consisting of oncologists, palliative care physicians, nurses, pharmacy staff, a clinical dietician and a social worker. Access is also available to a hospital chaplain.
- A new \$3 million linear accelerator is now operational at Sault Area Hospital's new radiation treatment bunker, in collaboration with the regional cancer program of Sudbury Regional Hospital.
- Teaching opportunities are available through the Northern Ontario School of Medicine.
