- The Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre is a 375-bed acute care facility that serves a regional population of 250,000. It offers integrated Cancer Care with a High Dose Brachytherapy Operating Room and a developed supportive regional program.
- The Regional Cancer Centre for Northwestern Ontario, housed within the Health Sciences Centre, has a 21-bed acute oncology unit and provides supportive, full continuum prevention and screening services.
- The medical oncologist's clinical portfolio would include:
 - Membership with the Clinical Trials Team
 - Membership with the Systemic Therapy Network and the Community Oncology Program
 - Membership with the Medical Oncology Associates – Thunder Bay
 - Membership with the Cancer Care Ontario Systemic Treatment Program Committee
 - Participation with the local Oncology Associates on-call group (medical oncology, radiation oncology, general practitioner in oncology)
- The Oncology group is also active in the teaching of medical students, family practice residents and internal medicine residents.
