## Two Great Places to Work

### *The City of Kawartha Lakes Family Health Team (CKLFHT)*

*This dynamic, collaborative team provides patient-centred, interdisciplinary, primary health care to a diversity of patients in the City of Kawartha Lakes.*

- CKLFHT is led by 29 family physicians and includes nurse practitioners, family health nurses and medical receptionists. Soon to join are pharmacists, a psychologist, a social worker, and occupational and respiratory therapists.
- CKLFHT is committed to patient self-care, health promotion and chronic disease management, as well as ongoing professional development for health-care professionals.
- Clinic hours and time commitment are flexible for both locum (short- or long-term) and permanent positions.
- Compensation is blended-capitation base for permanent positions and 70/30 split for locum positions.

### *The Kawartha Lakes Community Health Centre (CHC)*

*The CHC is a division of Community Care City of Kawartha Lakes Health and Community Support programs.*

- The primary care team consists of physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, a dietician, social worker, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, health promotion coordinator and foot care specialist.
- Locum and permanent positions are available.
- Hours are flexible for both locum (short- or long-term) and permanent positions.
- Compensation is salary-based.
- All overhead costs are assumed by the CHC.

Lindsay is located at the heart of the City of Kawartha Lakes, a rural landscape with over 250 lakes and rivers and crisscrossed by the Trent Severn Waterway. A prime cottaging destination, only agriculture surpasses tourism as its biggest business. While Lindsay is proud of its rural heritage, it is committed to providing big city services to its sophisticated, active population of 20,000. Its newly expanded Ross Memorial Hospital and vibrant, Victorian-inspired downtown are testament to the town's investment in its future. ## Great Benefits for You

*In addition to the Kawartha Lakes Health Care Initiative (KLHCI) incentives below, local businesses also offer family physicians a variety of community-based benefits.*

- **Family Practice Office Grant plus Rent Grant**  
KLHCI will provide reimbursement to an agreed amount for expenses and office rent incurred in the set-up of a physician's family practice during the first year of a four-year Return of Service (ROS).
- **Professional Fees Grant**  
If a physician joins a practice with existing infrastructure (i.e. Community Health Centre), KLHCI will provide reimbursement to an agreed amount for professional fees in the first year of a four-year ROS agreement.
- **Relocation Costs**  
KLHCI will provide reimbursement to an agreed amount for relocation costs to the City of Kawartha Lakes during the first year of a four-year ROS agreement.

- **Continuing Medical Education**  
KLHCI will provide reimbursement to an agreed amount for Continuing Medical Education expenses in each of the second, third and fourth year of the ROS agreement.
- **Office Set-Up Consulting**  
KLHCI will provide assistance as required to the physician in setting up a family practice office.
