- Enjoy teaching, curriculum development, research and publishing opportunities through the clinic's teaching links with The University of Western Ontario and McMaster University. The clinic has regularly taken students and residents in the practice for more than 20 years.
- Are part of a Family Health Team that includes a social worker, nurse practitioner, chiroprapist, kinesiologist, dietician, pharmacist and nurse educator.
- Work with a four-site hospital offering up-to-date equipment and access to more than 50 specialists in Owen Sound and tertiary care at hospitals in London and Kitchener. The clinic itself has Practice Solutions EMR.

Physicians in Chesley:

- Earn on average \$382,000 (+/- 24% depending on the number of rostered patients).
- Are eligible for a \$81,600 Northern and Rural Recruitment and Retention Initiative grant over 4 years.
- May be eligible for a significant community bonus with a 4 year commitment.
- Have a CME stipend of \$3,000.
- Enjoy turn-key office space rent-free for the first year in a medical clinic to be doubled in size in 2011.
- Have 8 weeks off per year for education and vacation depending on locum coverage.
- Benefit from allowances for moving expenses, fees at various ski and golf clubs, as well as sporting and cultural events, all of which can be tailored to personal needs and preferences.
