

# Come and explore "the road less travelled" Rainy River, Ontario

Don't let the name fool you – the Town of Rainy River is located in one of the sunniest areas of Northwestern Ontario, just five minutes from the Minnesota/Ontario border and southeast of Lake of the Woods.

Rainy River needs a new family physician to join its exceptionally stable physician workforce; here, the average length of stay is over ten years. Scope of practice includes patient health care at the Rainy River Medical Clinic as well as in-patient and emergency coverage at the Rainy River Health Centre. In addition to core practice qualifications, ACLS, ATLS and computer skills to access EMR are required.

## A Great Place to Work

- The Rainy River Health Centre is a modern hospital with three acute-care beds, 21 long-term beds and a 24-hour emergency department.
- It serves a catchment area of 2,700 comprised of the Town of Rainy River, surrounding municipalities and two First Nations communities.
- The ER has a portable ultrasound machine, a point-of-care lab and X-ray in the afternoons and on-call at other times. It is a low volume and low acuity facility with bigger cases seen from time to time.
- There is an active, locally developed cardiac rehabilitation program.
- A nurse practitioner handles most of the pre-natal, post-natal, well-baby and well-woman care.
- A superb new riverfront residence for locums and medical students/residents is slated for completion in 2012.

## A Great Place to Live and Play

Rainy River rewards those who live here with clean air, no traffic, stunning wildlife and natural beauty. It's a safe and peaceful place to raise a family with plenty of all-season sports and recreational choices for adults and children alike. Real estate is very inexpensive, with access to gorgeous cottage country on Lake of the Woods or any number of smaller lakes.

While Rainy River is a small community, it offers easy and convenient access to larger centres. For city recreation and shopping, Winnipeg, Minneapolis, and Thunder Bay are all within easy driving distance.

Fort Frances, Ontario and International Falls, Minnesota are an hour's drive away. The International Falls airport connects to anywhere in the world via Minneapolis, while the airport in Fort Frances connects to Canadian destinations via Thunder Bay.
