



## Practice as an ED Physician Assistant in Windsor, Ontario

The Department of Emergency Medicine at the Hôtel-Dieu Grace Hospital is seeking to hire a Physician Assistant to work in the emergency department.

As a PA at the HDGH ED you will become an integral part of one of the best emergency department teams in Ontario. Hôtel-Dieu Grace Hospital is a large acute care community hospital with a high percentage of tertiary services. Our major programs provide the regional service in trauma, renal dialysis, neurosurgery, cardiac catheterization / angioplasty, and adult acute psychiatry. The annual ED volume of combined pediatric and adult visits is 60,000.
