

We want you. A call for Transitional Councils and Registrars for New Health Regulatory Colleges: Homeopathy, Kinesiology, Naturopathy, and Psychotherapy

Transitional Councils of new health regulatory Colleges have been established by the *Homeopathy Act, 2007*, *Kinesiology Act, 2007*, *Naturopathy Act, 2007* and *Psychotherapy Act, 2007* to regulate the practice of homeopathy, kinesiology, naturopathy and psychotherapy in the public interest. A transitional Council exercises the powers of a regular Council of a health regulatory College to carry out the statutory objectives of a College to serve and protect the public interest. The new Colleges will regulate the professions in the public interest by ensuring that individuals have access to services provided by competent health professionals, and that individuals are treated with sensitivity and respect in their dealings with health professionals. Members of the new Colleges will be governed in accordance with the *Homeopathy Act, 2007*, *Kinesiology Act, 2007*, *Naturopathy Act, 2007* or *Psychotherapy Act, 2007*, the Health Professions Procedural Code, the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*, and the regulations and by-laws of their respective College. Colleges develop and maintain standards of practice, entry to practice requirements, standards of professional ethics, and promote and develop standards for continuing competence among its members. Various committees of the Colleges function in a quasi-judicial role with respect to the issuance, suspension and revocation of certificates of registration to practise in Ontario.

Council Members

You are an expert, clinical or academic, in the practice of homeopathy, kinesiology, naturopathy or psychotherapy, an expert in health professional regulation or the health sector or public administration; or a person with demonstrated interest or experience in public service. You have a commitment to the principles and values of public service. Members are appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council for a specified term, subject to renewal. These are part-time positions.

Transitional Registrars

As a Transitional Registrar, reporting to the Transitional Council and the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, you will assist in establishing and operating a College, and developing and implementing regulations, by-laws and policies related to the practice of homeopathy, naturopathy or psychotherapy. In addition to 3 or more years of management or leadership experience in legal, health-care or professional regulation settings, you have a thorough understanding of the legislative process and health professional regulation, and excellent oral and written communication skills. Bilingualism in English and French is an asset. This full-time position is appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council for a three-year term. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
